In today's gospel reading (Luke 2.41-52) we have a glimpse of the early life of Jesus. We see the normality of his early years as a Jewish boy – circumcision and yearly attendance at the feast of the Passover. We also see it in the way that he was raised by the village. It is not surprising that Jesus could go missing for a while. We see the normality of Jesus' early years in the way he grows. Verse 40 says that he grew and became strong; he was filled with wisdom and the grace of God was upon him. In verse 52 we read that Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and people. This was a genuine incarnation.

As we near the end of 2015 and begin 2016 let's be open to the Holy Spirit that we might grow in wisdom and be aware that the grace of God is upon us. Let us grow in stature as disciples of Christ and let us treasure these things.
