Today as we meet in worship most of our youth and young adults will be at the Revolution camp at Adare campsite, Victor Harbor. Youth and young adults from Westbourne Park and Gawler Uniting Churches also attend. Please pray for the camp until they return home to the church at 5pm Monday.

From now until Pentecost the Old Testament reading is replaced by readings from the Book of Acts. These readings recount the interactions of the early Christian community with all kinds of people and one of the central themes is the resurrection of Jesus. In today's Acts reading (Acts 3.12-19) Peter is responding to the healing of a lame man. Some people wanted to attribute this healing to the disciples but Peter quickly points out that it is God that does the healing and that in particular it is faith in Jesus that makes the difference. The disciples are witnesses to the resurrection of Christ and the resurrection life of Christ brings the possibility of new life for all.

Christ is risen indeed!
