If you are new or visiting Adelaide West Uniting Church we are pleased you are here. A Welcome to Adelaide West information sheet is available in the foyer or from the stewards.

Tomorrow is the 38th anniversary of the Uniting Church. We are a very young church by nearly everyone's standard. Yet we have the same joy as any church in knowing God and sharing the wonder of that with those we meet. The challenges we face in being an effective missional community are also the same but they are not new. The Corinthians reading set for today (2 Corinthians 6.1-13) tells of Paul's hardships – beatings, sleepless nights, hunger, hard work, imprisonment and the list goes on. The New Testament reading (Mark 4.35-41) has the disciples caught in a storm. Both groups find their strength in the presence of God. Paul talks about being in the Spirit and the power of God. The disciples call on Jesus and the storm is calmed.

Jesus calls the disciples to faith and to let go of their fear. Paul knows God's presence and calls for the affection of the Corinthian church. In all of this Paul says that now is the time of God's favour, now is the day of salvation. As Malcolm Gordon said last Sunday, if today feels a lot like a Good Friday then some form of resurrection is bound to be near.
