Today's lectionary gospel reading is the parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10.25-37). We know the story well and its application is just as challenging today as it ever was. We live in a world with great divisions and every day we see the violent outcomes of those divisions on our TV screens. The federal elections have elected some new members who will heighten differences and tensions in our society. As disciples of Christ, though, we are called not only to love God but to love our neighbour as well.

As the parable suggests we don't get to choose who will be a neighbour and what will be the limits of our care. We are simply called to love and listen and show mercy. Others will know that we are Christians when we love our neighbour and perhaps especially when our love overcomes barriers that others want to put in place. Let our actions and our words build a healthy community where all are welcome.
