We also have a tax collector who is so overwhelmed by his sinfulness that he cannot lift his eyes from staring at the ground. Perhaps this is not a story of either or but it points out that we can act like both of these characters.

In fact whenever we come to God asking for mercy that is what we will receive. Psalm 3.3 says, "But you, O Lord, are a shield around me, my glory, and the one who lifts up my head." When we come before God unsure of where we stand we find a loving God who lifts our head and even anoints it with oil.
