Transfiguration Sunday

Today we come to the end of the season of Epiphany. Each season ends with a celebration day and this week the celebration is Transfiguration Sunday. In Epiphany the focus is on learning things about Jesus. Having seen and learnt all sorts of things during Epiphany Transfiguration Sunday gathers some of the disciples on a high mountain. High mountains were places were people expected to encounter the divine and clouds were often present. There are a number of times in the Jewish scriptures where divine encounters happen on mountain tops. For a moment those present see beyond the normal things of life and see something more of who God is what God's desires are for our world.

In the reading today there is a voice and Jesus' direct connection with God is highlighted. Jesus is God's beloved. We all are. And we are challenged to listen deeply to Jesus. All of us have places where it seems easier to encounter God. Some people call these thin places. Wherever your thin place is the Transfiguration invites you to go there and listen for the voice of Jesus. It will be a place where love is experienced, where hope is found and where a desire to transform the world to be a place of justice, peace and wholeness will be rekindled.
